Friends shared in a multicultural worship event that truly reflected the vibrancy of the Spirit's work among Hispanics. Some partnership ministries were



highlighted including the Bethel Friends Church in Hugoton, Kansas where Pastors Eric Mason and Francisco Orozco (pictured left) cooperate to minister to the

entire community through a Spanish-speaking congregation.
